

GUIDELINES FOR AUTHORS AND CONTRIBUTORS

1. Please ensure that the subject of the article is of general interest to the technology enthusiasts and professionals
2. Send the manuscript through e-mail or CD, in Open Office doc. or any other text format, using MS-word, Write, Notepad etc to editsec@efyindia.com (mail CD with print to editor Electronics For You, D-87/1, Okhla Industrial Area, Phase1, New Delhi 110020)
3. Include your brief bio-data with the manuscript, especially when writing for the first time for the publication
4. Send photographs and illustrations (together with their captions) to go with the article, as they make the article attractive and more readable
5. The manuscript should not exceed 4000 words including equivalent space for illustrations. If longer, it should be possible to serialize the article in two or more parts
6. In case you are using non-standard letters/symbols (Greek characters, mathematical symbols etc), use them consistently throughout the text and append a list of all such characters/symbols with a lexicon of what each one of them represents
7. Avoid use of rare symbols and equations, but without sacrificing its quality and content, so that it can be understood by a larger cross-section of the readers
8. The illustrations must be neat and clean, even if drawn on a paper
9. Tables should bear short descriptive titles and table columns should bear headings
10. Elaborate the abbreviations used as far as possible
11. Give appropriate headings and sub-headings in the article
12. The manuscript for an article should not be a copy of someone else's published or unpublished work - although it cannot always be totally original or a piece of author's own research work. If a dispute or doubt does come up at any stage, the author should be able to defend himself/herself against infringement of copyright etc
13. Use only the Metric system of units in the text. If need be, the British system equivalent dimensions may be shown within parenthesis
14. While including maps in articles, ensure only govt. approved version of Indian maps are used
15. The editors reserve the right to suitably edit the articles including diagrams. All efforts are made to inform the contributors about major changes before publishing their articles. However, due to limitation of time, it may not always be possible to wait for their concurrence
16. If you wish to be paid some specific minimum amount for the article, please inform the Editor while forwarding the manuscript. Otherwise, the editors will use their discretion to determine the honorarium to be paid, after publication of the article
17. After publication of an article and payment of the honorarium, the contributed article becomes the property of the publishers. So it can be reused elsewhere, with the author's name intact
18. For do-it-yourself type articles, including 'circuit ideas' and 'construction projects,' and software it is essential that the same are properly tested beforehand for their proper working. The prototypes should be kept handy for dispatch to EFY when specifically requested. Indicate the cost of the prototype while forwarding the same, so that EFY at its discretion may either reimburse its cost suitably or return the prototype
